

What you'll do:

- Remove snow using a snow plow and heavy equipment for several hours at a time, depending on the amount of snowfall
- Must be available each time it snows and report either to a central location or directly to the jobsite
- Place removed snow in appropriate locations, avoiding piling it on trees, shrubs, fire hydrants or sidewalks
- Report any concerns or incidents to your direct Supervisor
- Fill out a job sheet as soon as you are finished working after each snow removal operation
- Participate in maintaining a safe and secure work environment for team employees and clients by adhering to company safety policies
- Be aware of safety issues or concerns, and report them to the appropriate Supervisor
- Perform other tasks as assigned by supervisor/manager

- Able to work overnight in the winter month
